2025 D'JAM JAZZ LEGEND AWARDS

Each year, the D'JAM consortium recognizes four individuals in distinct categories for their positive impact on jazz as a national and international treasure. The categories are:

JAZZ ARTIST: Given to a distinguished artist whose body of work, history in the community, and contributions to the evolution of jazz music in North Texas are exemplary, and who embodies the concept of collaboration and support for other artists.

JAZZ EDUCATOR: Given to a jazz musician and educator who has been instrumental in the development and molding of young jazz artists in the primary and secondary school environment who has the respect and support of his/her peers.

JAZZ SUPPORTER: Given to a person or artist who has promoted and supported jazz and jazz artists in North Texas through promotion, financial support, providing opportunities to perform, volunteering, or other means of elevating local jazz artists in our community.

JAZZ INNOVATOR: Given to a jazz artist who has demonstrated excellence of craft, originality in his/her music, and innovation as a performer.

JAZZ ARTIST - LYNN SEATON



Lynn Seaton, Regents Professor of Jazz Studies at UNT, is a world-renowned bassist known for his deep swing and innovative technique. He's toured with legends like Count Basie and Tony Bennett, performed globally, recorded over 125 albums, and earned a Fulbright Scholarship. Seaton directs the UNT Jazz Double Bass Workshop, mentors students worldwide, and leads his own trio.

JAZZ EDUCATOR - DUANE DURRETT



Duane Durrett, Dean of Fine Arts at Weatherford College, is a drummer, educator, and leader in jazz performance and education. He heads the Duane Durrett Quartet and has enriched the community with cultural programs. His 2020 "Traces of Bird" performance highlighted his dedication to jazz. Durrett inspires students through his dual passion for music and education.

JAZZ SUPPORTER - MARY D'ETIENNE



Mary d'Etienne, known as the "Booker T Mom," has been a pillar of the Dallas jazz community for decades. A dedicated supporter, she began her love of jazz in the 1940s and has remained a passionate advocate ever since. Now 92, Mary still attends shows weekly, encouraging musicians and keeping jazz vibrant in North Texas through her unwavering support.

JAZZ INNOVATOR - GARRY WILLIAMS



Garry Williams, Principal of Booker T. Washington HSPVA, is a jazz vocalist, educator, and arts advocate. He has led PreK-12 arts programs, partners with top arts groups, and has performed with Uptown Players and the Dallas Symphony. A UNT alum, Garry champions excellence in arts and education, shaping the next generation of creative leaders in Dallas.
